## **GENERAL RULES FOR GUIDANCE OF CADETS**

1	Cadets must wish the ladies, members of the staff and visitors followed by 'Sir' or 'Madam' and salute service officers followed by 'Jai Hind Sir' at all times.
2	They must keep perfect silence while : (a) Fall- in (b) Stepping into the school main building, particularly in Manekshaw Auditorium, Classrooms, laboratories and during preparatory periods. (c) In the Dining–Hall. (d) In the Houses after 2100 Hr.
3	They must safeguard the property of school. Any damage observed must be brought to the notice of Class teacher/ House Master /Duty Master of the day immediately.
4	They must be "Punctual" and reach well in time for all activities.
5	No Cadet should leave the school campus without prior Permission from Vice Principal/ Sr Master/ House Master.
6	Cadet must not tease Bees or pluck leaves and flowers from the garden.
7	They must be polite at all the times in their dealings with friends, seniors, strangers and ladies.
8	They must always talk in ENGLISH.
9	They must write letters / make phone calls to their parents regularly, at least, once a week.
10	Cadets are not permitted to keep electronic gadgets.
11	Cadets are to wear Head Gear in uniform at all times whenever they are outside the classroom/Houses/Mess.

12	They must observe dress code while in the school building, in the Cadets' Mess or at the play fields / training area.
13	Cadets should refrain from using foul language/Sarcastic remarks/Hurt religious sentiments/ Illtreat / Emotional blackmail/ In-Fight/ Man Handle/Peer Pressure for wrong deeds against any cadets in any form.
14	Ragging is strictly prohibited.
15	Cadets will not visit the out of bound areas such as cook house, Senior House/ Junior House, Houses of Masters without any valid reason, River and any such areas outside the school premises.
16	No party/ celebration is to be organised in the Houses.

## **TURN-OUT AND HYGIENE**

Cadets must maintain a neat and smart appearance at all times. They should ensure:-

1	Brush their teeth daily twice- once in the morning and once before going to bed.
2	Keep their finger and toe nails trimmed and clean.
3	Take bath every day.
4	Take their hair- cut twice a month. Sikh cadets must take head-bath, at least, once a week, especially on Sundays.
5	Comb the hair properly.
6	Polish their shoes every day.
7	Wash their socks and under garments every day.
8	Dress-up for various activities as per rules.
9	Keep their sleeves down in Mufti.
10	Always be in appropriate shoes other than shoe excuse by Medical Authority.

## **DORMITORY DISCIPLINE**

1	<p>Cadets are forbidden to.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) Enter their dorms during working hours.</li><li>(b) Borrow or lend money.</li><li>(c) Keep valuable items with them including Mobiles etc.</li><li>(d) Bring eatable inside the dormitory.</li><li>(e) Visit other houses after Dinner.</li></ul>
2	<p>They should mark their garments and mend/stitch buttons on Sundays.</p>
3	<p>Cadets should remember to.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) Visit the toilet before going to bed.</li><li>(b) Make their beds once before going to sleep and again after waking up and maintain kit lay out at all times.</li><li>(c) Close the water taps, when not in use.</li><li>(d) Flush the urinals and lavatories after use.</li><li>(e) Switch- off fans and lights when not required.</li><li>(f) Cadets should use their own soap and towel.</li><li>(g) Senior cadets should shave regularly.</li></ul>
4	<p>They should carry-out orders and instructions passed by school through Appointments.</p>

\* All Houses will be locked during Academic / Preparatory / Games timings.

\* School property not to be damaged. In case of any deliberate damage, the repair cost is to be borne by the cadet along with disciplinary action. In case, the damage is done to the school property and no cadet owns up, the repair cost of the same will be recovered from all the cadets.

## CLASS - ROOM DISCIPLINE

1	<b><u>When a teacher goes to take a class, the monitor will bring the class to</u></b> "Savdhan" and handover the Parade State to the teacher.
2	The class-room furniture and walls must be kept clean and tidy. Damage, if any, should be immediately brought to the notice of the class teacher by monitor.
3	Whenever the cadets leave the classrooms, the class-rooms must be locked properly and all lights & fans switched- off
4	Doors and windows are to be kept opened at all times during the school hours.
5	Smart boards should not be used in the absence of teacher or during breaks.

## MESS DISCIPLINE

1	Cadets should reach the mess on time and in designated attire.
2	Each meal will begin and end with a Grace. Cadets must stand in attention for the prayer.
3	Cadets should not start eating or drinking water till the prayer has been completed.
4	Silence should be maintained in the mess at all times.
5	Cadets should not waste food.
6	Cadets should learn and observe mess etiquettes.
7	Cadets should not argue with the waiters/mess staff.
8	Cadets should not compel the waiters to serve them anything which is not on menu.
9	Cadets should seek prior permission from the Mess Manager for dining the parents or guardians in the mess.
10	Cadets should leave the mess only after the Grace.



## **DUTIES OF THE SCHOOL APPOINTMENTS**

1	Ensure smart turn-out and discipline of all cadets through other House and School appointments.
2	Ensure that all cadets are well in time for all activities through other House and School appointments.
3	Assist the Duty Master.
4	Ensure that each House maintains Mess discipline through other House and School appointments.
5	Report irregularities, if any, in discipline, turn-out, mess etiquettes, general behavior etc. to the Duty Master.
6	Report to the Vice Principal / Administrative Officer for daily briefing after the VII / VIII period, and pass on instructions, if any, to the cadets in the mess during the lunch and dinner timings.
7	Ensure no acts of Ragging by any cadets.
8	To participate in all the activities and be a role model for all the cadets.
9	Execute all the instructions as given by School Administration.
10	To take rounds of the school during random timings and ensure no acts of indiscipline.
11	Turn Out inspections and House Inspections prior to Inspections by School authorities is to be conducted along with school appointments.

## **DUTIES OF THE SCHOOL VICE CAPTAIN**

1	To be in sync with School Captain and execute his responsibility diligently.
2	Keep a copy of all the school orders and instructions in a proper folder for reading out in the Assembly as directed.
3	Read-out the school calendar for the week on every Monday in the School Central Assembly.
4	To participate in all the activities and be a role model for all the cadets.
5	To take rounds of the school during random timings and ensure no acts of indiscipline.
6	Execute all the instructions as given by School Administration.

## **DUTIES OF THE SCHOOL ADJUTANT**

1	To ensure smart turn-out and discipline of the cadets.
2	To ensure that all cadets are well in time for all activities.
3	To assist the School Captain and Duty Master for attendance and discipline.
4	To take roll-call in the Morning Assembly & Preps.
5	To meet the Vice Principal / Administrative Officer /Senior master/Duty master for instructions / guidance on regular basis.
6	Ensure all cadets are marching in column of twos in the left side of the road.
7	To announce instruction/information's, if any, in the Cadets' Mess.
8	To take rounds of the school during random timings and ensure no acts of indiscipline.
9	Execute all the instructions as given by School Administration.

## **DUTIES OF THE SPORTS CAPTAIN**

1	To ensure that all cadets are well in time for PT and Games.
2	To take roll-call during PT and games and handover the parade statement to the PTI.
3	To assist the games/ Sports Co-Ordinator and PT Instructors in organizing sports and games activities.
4	To be in sync with other appointments in maintaining the School discipline during games and sports.
5	To keep up the sportsman spirit amongst all the cadets.
6	To take rounds of the school during random timings and ensure no acts of indiscipline.
7	Execute all the instructions as given by School Administration.

### **DUTIES OF THE HOUSE CAPTAIN**

1	Will himself set a good example in turn-out, punctuality and good behavior for all cadets of his house.
2	Will promote a spirit of honor and sportsmanship among the boys of his house.
3	Will be responsible to the House Master for the general discipline and turn-out of his house and will bring to his notice all cases of indiscipline.
4	Will keep close liaison with the School Appointments.
5	Will explain relevant school orders to the cadets of his house and ensure that they are fully carried out.
6	Will deposit the "Lost & Found" property to the Administrative Officer.
7	Will keep close liaison with all the prefects of his house & guide and help them in carrying-out their duties.
8	Will execute any other task assigned by the House Master and conduct the House Meetings.
9	Ensure no ragging.
10	Execute all the instructions as given by School Administration.

### **DUTIES OF THE HOUSE VICE CAPTAIN**

1	To maintain close liaison with the House Captain.
2	To ensure hygiene of his House cadets.
3	To assist in maintaining an account of the house property.
4	To maintain the duty roster for guarding the house during evening and night preps as an when required.

### **DUTIES OF THE HOUSE PREFECT**

1	To assist the House Captain and Vice- Captain in the performance of their duties.
2	To perform any other work assigned by the House Master.

## **DUTIES OF THE CLASS MONITOR**

1	Class Monitor will be responsible to the Class teacher.
2	Ensure discipline in the class.
3	Ensure that class room is cleaned daily and waste paper is put in the Dust bin. Ensure systematic distribution and disposal of snacks.
4	Ensure that chalk and duster are available in the class- room.
5	Maintain the inventory of furniture and electric fittings in the class-room.
6	Ensure that the class-room is locked after school hours and whenever the cadets move out for any reason during working hours.
7	Arrange issue of stationery and books.
8	Will report any loss of breakage immediately to the class teacher.
9	Ensure that Light and Fans are switched off when cadets move out of the classrooms.
10	Will ensure the smart class equipments fixed in the classes are functioning properly.
11	Will bring the class to Savdhan whenever Teacher/Adm Offr/Vice Principal/Principal enter in to the class.
12	Will have the accountability of every cadet of the class.
13	Must maintain the following records on daily basis. (a) Split-up syllabus. (b) Monitor the progress of the syllabus as per split up syllabus (c) Period wise attendance of the students.

## **DUTIES OF THE CLASS ASSISTANT MONITOR**

1	Will assist the monitor in discharge of his duties.
2	Will fill the attendance of the class in the first period in the column on the black-board/glass-board and keep it up-to date in each period.

## **VISITORS**

Parents and authorised visitors are permitted to meet the cadets only on Sundays and school holidays from 1400 Hr to 1800 Hr with prior permission from Housemaster / Senior Master. They should enter their particulars in the register kept with the chowkidar at the main gate. They should also enter the time of arrival, and departure. Entry is not permitted to dormitories.

## **TURNOUT INSPECTION BY PRINCIPAL**

Points awarded for inspection will contribute to Inter House Championship Banner. Turn out inspection will be carried out on first Monday of the month. one Point will be awarded for each good turn out and negative marks will be awarded for unsatisfactory turn out. Points thus scored will contribute towards Inter House Championship Banner. Following will be taken into consideration :-

- (a) General hygiene and cleanliness of the cadets.
- (b) Proper turnout and haircut of the cadets.
- (c) Command and control of the leader.
